Conditions of Sale

The Auction Catalogue

The Auction Catalogue contains the artworks to be sold on the Auction from April 21th to April 23th of the present year. Auction take place online through Instagram Stories.

Rules of Auction

It is expressly noted that all purchasers attending the Auction agree that they have been made aware and understand the Rules of Auction.

The Auction

The highest accepted bidder shall be the purchaser of the respect artwork(s). In the event of a dispute as to the identity of the highest bidder C·Armenta may reauction the artwork concerned, declare the successful purchaser, or remove the artwork from the auction.

Online Bidding

Registered bidders participating by online auction must be aware that the auctioneer cannot accommodate for time zone or slow/lost internet connection. Should it occur that an online bid reflects after the auctioneer marks the Artwork as "SOLD". *An Artwork will be mark as "Sold" after 12 hours with no bids.* Online bidders can pace pre-bids/Max offers prior to the auction commencing which the online auction administrator calls on behalf the online bidder in bidding increments up to the maximum/ pre bid amount.

Due to the above, if you're interested in one artwork please bid early.

Locations of Artworks

Artworks are Located in Playa del Carmen, Mexico. The Purchaser is responsible for the shipping costs. If you're interested to know the shipping cost for a specific artwork please send an email with your full address to info@c-armenta.com.

Please consider the shipping costs before purchase an artwork!

Additional Terms/ Suspensive conditions

The purchaser Shall be Bound by all additional terms and conditions. After an artwork is marked as "Sold", a sale for the artwork shall be finally and irrevocably concluded. Your bid is final and binding on every artwork purchased.

Conditions of the artworks

All the paintings are shipped rolled in a tube unless it is clearly described in the auction catalogue. Sculptures are shipped in a Wooden box container.

Cancellation

Bids & invoices cannot be cancelled.

Payment and Delivery.

Full Payment must be made 48 hours after the auction. Payment is only accepted via Wire transfer, if you want to pay using PayPal or Credit Card via Mercado Pago please contact **info@c-armenta.com**


IVA is not included in the final price of the sale, in case of a Mexican Purchaser needs an invoice.

Delivery

The delivery of the artworks will be 3-5 days after full payment of the sale and shipping costs. Each artwork will be sent with a Certificate of Authenticity and Artwork Statement.

Process of Bidding

Every artwork will be uploaded as an Instagram Story, stories will be visible just for the registered people in my close friend list, that's why is a private auction. Each Story will show the picture of the artwork and a question sticker. The next picture shows an example of the first story of an artwork.



Every time a collector makes a bid, a story will be uploaded as an evidence that someone has made an offer and then the story of the artwork will be uploaded with the new price, this for purposes of transparency.

For artworks with starting Price from 100 USD and over the bid must be adding multiples of 25 USD.

Once an artwork does not receive an offer within 12 hours, the sale will close and the winner will be the bidder with the highest bid.
